

Supply List for Happily Ever After Class

Basic machine sewing supplies (machine, needles, bobbins, etc.)
Basic sewing supplies (pins/pincushion, seam ripper, fabric scissors, etc.)
Fabric marking pencil and small ruler
Thread in a coordinating or neutral color for your fabrics
Fabrics as per instructions below

Our project is ultimately a 66" x 78" quilt. You will learn how to make the blocks in class so that you can finish the quilt on your own at home.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

If you're making the entire quilt:

15 fat quarters of assorted prints in various colors or the equivalent in scraps
5 yards of background fabric for blocks and borders or the equivalent in scraps (if you want a scrappy background)

If you're just making a few blocks:

Scraps of prints and 1/2 yard of a background fabric (scraps will work for this, too).

HOMEWORK

I recommend cutting enough pieces for 4 blocks, so you'll have plenty to work on during class, but still be able to change your mind easily if you decide to rearrange colors. I'm giving codes to each piece (A1, B2, etc.) so that you can label your pieces as you cut them, for easy identification when you get to class.

Instructions are for cutting one block, so you can mix up your scraps more easily. Then if you want scrappy backgrounds as well, it's easier to tell what you're doing. Just repeat this as many times as you need for your homework (I recommend four).

I'll provide a full pattern in class with instructions for the entire quilt.

From background fabric, cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" square (A1)
- (4) 2 1/2" squares (A2)
- (2) 2" x 9 1/2" rectangles (A3)
- (6) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (A4)
- (4) 2" x 5" rectangles (A5)

From Print #1 (for the inner ring), cut:

- (2) 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles (B1)
- (2) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (B2)

From Print #2 (for outer ring), cut:

- (4) 3 1/2" squares (C1)
- (4) 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles (C2)
